**Berg Injury Lawyers to Represent the Family
of Deceased Caltrans Worker**

ALAMEDA, Calif., Oct. 2, 2007—Berg Injury Lawyers will be representing the family of Djuan Bush, 24, who was struck by a car while he was repairing a guardrail on Interstate 580 last Tuesday.

Bush, a two-year employee of the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), was repairing a guardrail near Dublin on Sept. 25, when Michael Manes, who was not injured in the accident, lost control of his Porsche while going around a curve. Manes' car struck Bush and threw him onto the back of the Porsche, which then became pinned under a Caltrans truck.

As a result, Bush sustained multiple broken bones and was taken to Eden Medical Center, where he died later that evening. The death prompted California Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger to issue a statement offering his condolences to Bush's family and to order all flags to be flown at half-staff in Bush's honor. An investigation into the accident is currently underway.

"During the course of performing his job, Djuan tragically lost his life due to the carelessness of a motorist," said William Berg, founder and principal of Berg Injury Lawyers. "We will make sure that his family receives the justice they deserve."

Berg said that he and members of his firm are currently investigating the claim to determine what legal actions may be warranted.
