- **San Francisco**
Call Luxor Cab at (415) 282-4141.
- **Sacramento**
Call Yellow Cab Company of Sacramento at (916) 444-2222. Patrons must be picked up at a restaurant, hotel, or bar within Downtown Sacramento to qualify for a free ride.

Rides are for adults who have been drinking or who need a safe way home. Rides will be provided from a bar or restaurant to an individual's residence—not to other drinking locations. Due to the high number of requests on St. Patrick's Day, rides can't be guaranteed for everyone who calls; however, every attempt will be made to accommodate all requests. Drivers have the right to use their discretion when accepting fares.
